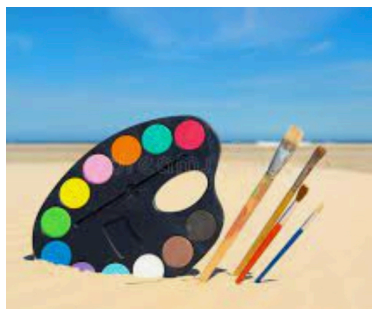

**Special Supplies:** Prismcolor Colored Pencils #916 Canary Yellow, #925 Crimson Lake, #908 Dark Green, #918 Orange, #1078 Black Cherry, #938 White, #926 Carmine Red, #1005 Lime Peel and #1077 Colorless Blender. Black permanent extra fine point Identi-Pen, Frixion Erasable Marker by Pilot, light box, scotch tape or painter's tape, kneaded eraser, hard cardboard for backing, JoSonja textile medium, small round paint brush to apply medium, pencil sharpener, paper towels, table cover.

For the class, please bring your regular acrylic painting supplies (including a flat to float with and a liner brush) and a waterproof pen. A size 03 or 05 work well. Barb used a Uni-ball 'vision' pen, size 'micro', for this, which they sell at office supply stores or online. They're cheaper than the Staedtler or Micron pens and work just as well... and are waterproof (they say this on the side, too.) Barb will supply the paint.
