Many of you may have received a card from our club when you were ill, had a special anniversary or another life event. This month I'd like to feature the woman behind those special greetings. Linda, How did you become interested in Decorative painting?

I think I tried Southern Elegance at least 3 times before I was happy with it. I love doing batik work and equally enjoy painting with acrylics.

Do you have any other hobbies besides painting?

Sewing also has always been a wonderful hobby for me. Back in the 1970s and 80s I made wedding dresses for others. Of course, I was working full time, so I'd be limited to one gown at a time -- but I really enjoyed the challenge. Before I knew it I was making bridesmaids dresses and outfits for Mother of the Bride! Nowadays I just enjoy sewing clothes for myself or doing some craft sewing.

What do you like about our painting club? What roles do you fulfill?

I was introduced to NCC back in the late 1980s -- it was a few years later that I joined CBDP which soon became my "home" group. I enjoyed the fellowship, teaching, and spending time painting with the other members. Friendships of many, many years continue to this day. Our club culture is one of learning together, sharing ideas, lending and receiving help and suggestions from others. I believe the members of our club are exceedingly generous in helping and encouraging one another.

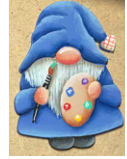
